

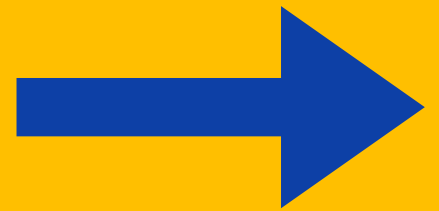

# Tips for a successful...

## Clothing Drive

### NEW Underwear

#### 1. Define your donors

Who are you asking to donate? Pick a place where you know a lot of people will get involved, like work, school, places of worship, and clubs. The more donors the better!

#### 2. Consider a theme to make it more fun

For instance, collect items that tie into a holiday, event, vibe, or season, and decorate your donation bins or signage accordingly.

#### 3. Set a timeframe for collecting donations

We suggest approximately 2-4 weeks.

#### 4. Promote your drive

Spread the word about your event before and during. Utilize bulletin boards, emails, social media, and workplace communication tools like Teams and Slack.

#### 5. Make it a game!

A little healthy competition can help keep donors engaged and increase donations. Organize donors into teams and see who can collect the most. Celebrate your success as a group.

#### 6. Donate to KiDs Closet
